Legislators are listed in both grade order as well as alphabetical order in this report card.

Grades are based on three factors:

1. Votes on bills related to SEIU's core legislative priorities: Health Care, Workers' Rights, Education Funding, Long Term Care, Fiscal Responsibility, and Immigration Reform.
2. An extra point was awarded each time a Legislator chief authored a bill that addressed SEIU's core legislative priorities.
3. Legislators who helped SEIU organizing or contract campaigns received extra points.

Senate Bills:

Omnibus Education Funding (HF6)

This stand-alone bill would have increased funding by \$51 per pupil. The bill passed both the Senate and House, but was **vetoed by the Governor**. A later budget omnibus bill did include an increase in per pupil funding.

REAL ID Noncompliance (HF3807)

SEIU opposes REAL ID, a federal program to create a nationwide ID card system. This would be an unfunded mandate, and there are many concerns related to privacy and immigration. A stand-alone bill prohibiting the state from implementing REAL ID passed both the Senate and House, but was **vetoed by the Governor**.

School Employee Health Care Pool (HF1875)

SEIU supported this bill that would have created a statewide pool for school employee health insurance. For the second session in a row, the Senate and House passed this bill, and for the second time, it was **vetoed by the Governor**.

Punishing Police/Immigration Separation of Duties (Hann Amendment to SF2869)

This amendment would have prohibited Local Government Aid payments to cities that separate city police from federal immigration duties. SEIU opposed this amendment. It failed to pass. A similar amendment also failed in the House.

Nursing Home Staffing Study (SF3563)

SEIU supported this study as part of the Seniors and Workers Coalition. It passed both the Senate and House and was **signed by the Governor**.

Minimum Wage Increase

(SF875 Conference Committee Report)

This bill would have increased the minimum wage to \$6.75 an hour effective July 24, 2008, and \$7.75 an hour effective July 24, 2009. The report passed both the Senate and House but was **vetoed by the Governor**.

House Bills:

Omnibus Education Funding (HF6)

This stand-alone bill would have increased funding by \$51 per pupil. The bill passed both the Senate and House, but was **vetoed by the Governor**. A later budget omnibus bill did include an increase in per pupil funding.

REAL ID Noncompliance (HF3807)

SEIU opposes REAL ID, a federal program to create a nationwide ID card system. This would be an unfunded mandate, and there are many concerns related to privacy and immigration. A stand-alone bill prohibiting the state from implementing REAL ID passed both the Senate and House, but was **vetoed by the Governor**.

Employee Free Choice Act resolution (SF543)

The House passed this resolution in support of federal legislation that would make it easier for workers to form a union, and would increase the penalties for union-busting employers. The Senate passed this bill in the 2007, and the House passed it in 2008. It was **vetoed by the Governor**.

School Employee Health Care Pool (HF1875)

SEIU supported this bill that would have created a statewide pool for school employee health insurance. For the second session in a row, the Senate and House passed this bill, and for the second time, it was **vetoed by the Governor**.

Strip Bus Safety Language from Transportation Bill (Urdahl Amendment to HF3800)

SEIU opposed this attempt to remove language concerning school bus safety reporting from the Transportation Bill. The amendment failed in the House.

Nursing Home Staffing Study (SF3563)

SEIU supported this study as part of the Seniors and Workers Coalition. It passed both the Senate and House and was **signed by the Governor**.

Minimum Wage Increase

(SF875 Conference Committee Report)

This bill would have increased the minimum wage to \$6.75 an hour effective July 24, 2008, and \$7.75 an hour effective July 24, 2009. The report passed both the Senate and House but was **vetoed by the Governor**.

Punishing Police/Immigration Separation of Duties (Seifert Amendment to HF3201)

This amendment would have prohibited Local Government Aid payments to cities that separate city police from federal immigration duties. SEIU opposed this amendment. It failed to pass. A similar amendment also failed in the Senate.
